Whilst the critical aid, relief and immediate needs have in the main now been met we continue to focus on specific projects we identify locally that still require ongoing support."*

Healthcare: Thailand Red Cross; provision for prosthetic limbs  
Childcare: Orphanage support  
Education: New classrooms, class equipment and play equipment  
Civil Works: Road building  
Animal Welfare: Providing for and treating homeless dogs and cats  
Nature: Landscape replanting and regeneration  
Employment: Part finance for the creation of a boatyard to restore the local fishing fleet  
Safety: Street lighting
